Role & Responsibilities

- Execute Release and characterization Testing (in- and outsourced tests) of development and clinical batches per GMP (including Start material, Raw material, in process, Drug Substance, Drug Product) and document results
- Execute daily operational QC activities, incl. but not limited to cleaning program; calibration, monitoring and maintenance of lab equipment, sample reception, registration and storage, environmental monitoring and recording, ordering of material and reagents in accordance with ERP and budget
- Record, report and Review data obtained for compliance to specifications (including double checks) and report abnormalities
- Initiate and follow-up on QC/QMS-related GMP documentation, including deviations/events, OOS and CAPA, under supervision
- Support to writing and revising SOPs and SOPs associated documents (incl. batch records, work files, checklists, sampling procedures) related to routine QC testing of development and clinical GMP batches in line with GMP
- Perform under supervision a wide variety of QC release tests, characterization tests and sampling procedures enabling release of clinical products according to the SOPs and in line with GMP
- Execute investigational/batch failure studies
- Check appropriate reception, registration, and storage of QC release samples (reference, back-up, retention) and characterization samples
- Contact outsourced CROs for testing under supervision (organization and preparation of shipments of samples, request and inspection of analysis, recording of results)
- Work in a constructive and flexible way in a team
